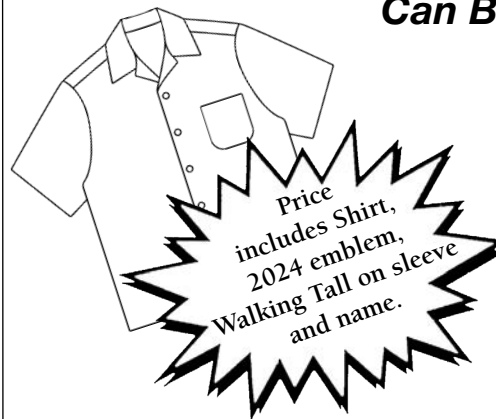

TRAVEL FUND

Recently, I have heard some grumblings about the possibility of donating money from our travel fund to the travel funds of other, smaller temples, within our association. Let me be clear, at this time, NONE of Ismailia's money has been given to any other temple. Like all travel funds, the money in them is owned by Tampa and administered by the temple. We are subject to the "2x rule", which means the temple can keep in their travel fund 2 times what they used the prior year. Anything over that Tampa can take at any point, if and when they feel it is necessary. For example, if Ismailia spent \$50,000.00 last year, supporting taking our kids to hospitals, maintaining vehicles, or any other expense associated with taking kids to the hospital (food, lodging, gas reimbursement, etc.), we are entitled to keep \$100,000.00 in our travel fund this year. Anything over that, Tampa has the right to take and add to their coffers. In order for us to gift the money to another temple's travel fund a few things have to happen. First, it requires Divan approval. Second, it must be brought up at a stated session, voted on, and approved by the membership. Finally, it must be sent to Tampa for approval, along with the minutes from both the Divan meeting and the stated session, and the outcome of the voting at both meetings. Every time we have followed these exact protocols. All Nobles of Ismailia have a voice in this. To express your concerns, show up for a stated session and let your voice be heard. We all became Shriners to better the lives of children, not only in our community, but in others. We all took the Shriners' creed, the very last part of which states, **"As Shriners we look beyond ourselves to serve the needs of others, especially children who cannot help themselves. We believe Shriners Hospitals to be the world's greatest philanthropy, and we covenant with each other to support its 'temples of mercy' with spirit, time, talent and means"**. This does not mean we will only support the children of our area. If there is a temple in our New York Ontario Shrine Association (NYOSA) that needs assistance, I do not see any harm in assisting them. Since we started doing this last year, we challenged other temples in our association to also step up and help out our smaller temples' travel funds. At fall NYOSA last year Cyprus accepted the challenge and donated \$8,000.00 to another temple's transportation fund. So, if Ismailia helping out other temples with donation from our transportation fund, again funds that DO NOT belong to Ismailia to help another temple's hospital transportation fund out offends you in anyway, please come to a stated session and voice your concerns. I hope this clears up any misinformation that might have been circulated that we are using Ismailia funds to help other temples out.

Shriners Legacy Month Graphics

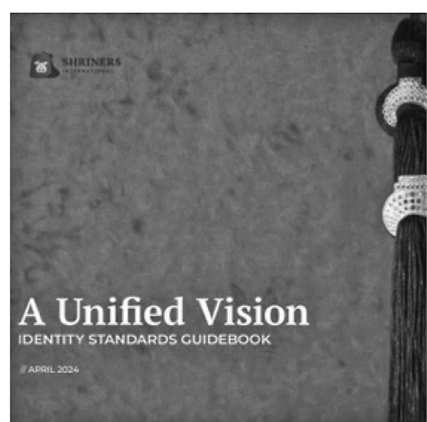


