Join the Ailiamsi Ladies on June 5, for their Court meeting beginning at 1:00 P.M. We will report on what happened at Grand Council.

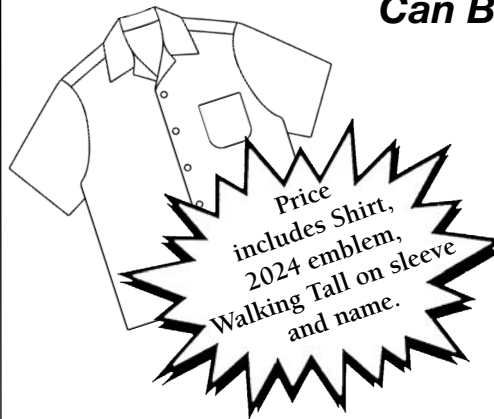
