

We have 8 ladies traveling to Supreme Session this June! We wish them safe travels and will be excited to have them share all they learned with us when they return!


Please remember to save your aluminum can tabs from your summer beverages and any other food items. These will be collected and turned in to help defray hospital transportation costs.


