

Hello Everyone,


August is leaving and the cooler weather has shown it's on the way. It's now time for Ailiamsi to get back to work.







Community Therapy Referral Success

In 2021, Shriners Children's Erie and Lexington implemented the Community Therapy Referral Program, with the first speech therapy visit in November of that year. This program allows a community physician to directly refer a patient to the rehabilitation/therapy services department for outpatient evaluation and treatment. The program has been very successful for Erie and approximately one-third of rehab visits are based on referrals from community-based providers. Thanks to the amazing success of Erie and Lexington, 10 additional Shriners Children's sites are now accepting the community therapy referrals: Chicago, Hawai'i, New England, Philadelphia, Portland, Southern California, Shreveport, Twin Cities, Spokane and St. Louis. This widespread implementation underscores the program's effectiveness and our organization's commitment to expanding access to specialized care for children across the country


