The Former President Was a Strong Supporter of Shriners Children's and a Shriners Honorary Ambassador

To my fellow Nobles,

It is with heavy heart that we are mourning the loss of President Jimmy Carter. His work in the years following his presidency to make the world a better place is remarkable and humbling. For us, the loss is also personal, as President Carter was devoted to our organizations and treasured his status as a Hasan Shriners Honorary Ambassador.

President Carter, who was 100, passed away Sunday. He was the oldest living U.S. president in history

President Carter and his wife, Rosalynn, were eager and caring supporters of Shriners Children's and our mission of providing life-changing medical care. Over the years, their personal support and that of the Carter Center helped us serve countless children around the world.

Lady Judy and I had the opportunity to meet President Carter on two occasions. At dinner with him at a Hasan Shriners Potentate's Ball in Albany, Georgia, we were struck by what a kind and down-to-earth man he was. Later, I was with the Imperial Divan to see him at the Carter Center, and was honored that he recognized and remembered me. It was such an honor to meet a man of his stature. He was always so gracious. His dedication to serving others and making the world a better place was evident

In 2016 the Carters appeared in a Valentine's-themed <u>public service announcement</u> for our healthcare system. President Carter said then, "We have been following the philanthropic efforts of Shriners Hospitals for many years, and we look forward to helping people understand they are a resource available when seeking medical care for their children."

Past Imperial Potentate Gary Bergenske recalled that President Carter made the PSA due to his passionate belief in the mission. "He donated his time and image to do this for Shriners Children's out of the goodness of his heart," Bergenske said. "He did that because he wanted to help the children we take care of."

Later the same year, members of the Carter Center traveled with a Shriners Children's medical team for an outreach clinic at St. Boniface hospital in Haiti. The Carter Center helped organize the medical mission, working directly with the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Disabilities of the Government of Haiti for approval.

President Carter was named Honorary Ambassador of Hasan Shriners at a ceremony in Albany, Georgia, in 2014. The honor was particularly meaningful to him, President Carter said, because his father was a Mason and a Shriner. That year, the Carter Center began working with Shriners Children's to expand access to medical care for children around the world.


In 2018, President Carter and the Carter Center assisted Shriners Children's in transporting children who were critically injured in a volcanic eruption in Guatemala, helping to arrange military transport and accompanying medical teams to get the children to our Galveston hospital.

He was honored by Shriners Children's with the Humanitarian Award in 2018 in recognition of his service on behalf of our mission and patients.

President Carter once said, "I have one life and one chance to make it count for something... My faith demands that I do whatever I can, wherever I am, whenever I can, for as long as I can with whatever I have to try to make a difference."

His lengthy humanitarian record reflects President Carter's deep devotion to serving others and making the world a better place. We are honored to count him as one of our strongest supporters, and we are humbled to share a special connection to this most extraordinary man. We grieve his loss and send our warmest condolences to the Carter family.







We are distressed to report that a few staff members have lost their homes, as did the family of one of Pasadena's patient ambassadors. Chief Nursing Officer Beverly Bokovitz told us that as Shriners Children's leaders and staff members in Pasadena navigate the wildfire challenges, we should rest assured that patient and employee safety are the first priority.

As a fraternity, we are called to stand together as brothers and to do all we can to help make the world a better place. We congratulate the efforts of our Al Malaikah brothers and commend them for their service. And we continue to send our best wishes and deepest concern to all who are impacted by this horrific, historic disaster.

SPRINGFIELD CLINIC NEWS

Greetings from the Springfield Clinic Board of Governor. I wanted to give you an update on what Springfield is up to. 80% of the patients at the clinic are treated for orthopedic conditions, 67% of the patients receive some sort of financial assistance. Last year they treated 6988 individual patients and had over 25,000 visits from those patients. In 2024 the fund raising goal was \$3,000,000.00 and they actually raised over \$8,000.000.00 – that is 274% over goal, also 85% of every dollar raised goes directly to patient care. Their philanthropy department is headed by Kerri Tichy who will be making a trip to Buffalo for our May 14 stated session to do a presentation We are working on either having a patient ambassador come out with her or someone from the marketing or POPS department to do a presentation as well. Marketing is headed by Jennifer Trass, a native of Tonawanda, so there were quite a few "Go Bills" during her presentation. There are some new and exciting things in the works @ Springfield including a triage burn clinic offered on the first Monday of every month and the newest is the Cranial Remolding program which is in its pilot stages and offered weekly as needed. As always there is a monetary need at the hospitals and some of the areas in most need are cranial facial/cleft lip and palate, cranial remolding, outpatient services (fracture care, scoliosis, sports injury, & urology), patient care, and rehab; so if you would like to donate to Springfield you can earmark it to go directly to one of these programs. 2025 is going to be an exciting year for the hospital as they celebrate their 100th anniversary and there are some fun events planned. At our next board meeting February 13 there will be a celebration with the staff. Saturday April 26 is our first ever Shriner Day (like Erie Hospital Day), Sunday June 8 is the community yard party, and Saturday October 18 is the fund raising Gala. Except for February, the board meetings are normally held the 3rd Thursday of every month, committee meetings start @ 8am, and the board meeting is generally @ lpm. If you have any questions, please feel free to reach out to me. Thanks again for putting your trust in me to be your Springfield Clinic Board representative.
