### 43 Years of Caring for Children in Cyprus

On March 2-9, 2024, a Shriners Children's outreach team conducted a medical clinic on the island of Cyprus. All three tenets of Shriners Children's mission - high quality care, education and research - were a part of this trip. The outreach activities resulted in treatment of 149 children, performance of seven high-level surgeries, fitting of orthotic and/or prosthetic devices for 41 children, and collection of 70 specimens for genomics research efforts.
