We march often during the summer and occasionally in other seasons, entertaining the public, especially kids. Most of our music is Sousa marches and the like: tunes familiar to Americans, including especially but not exclusively patriotic airs; most are

Time commitment is much less than most corps. We rehearse monthly fall through winter, then weekly in the spring to prepare for our busy summer performance schedule. We often march independently in civic parades and with local fire departments in field days parades. We sometimes ride on a trailer, so musicians who can't march can still perform with us and other Shrine units like our Ziyara Zanies clowns. Usually, we are not competing specifically as a D&B, so can welcome woodwinds and strings to join us.

Our D&B has cymbals, drums and bugles (soprano, baritone, contrabass) to lend to musicians who can't bring their own. We presume that other instruments are available from the inactive musical units.

We march so kids can walk, talk and enjoy life. Please join us, and encourage other musicians you know to join us, having fun doing good for others!


Handicap Parking at the **Shrine Center**

Dear Fellow Nobles,

I am sure you have seen pictures and videos of the devastation caused by the back-to-back hurricanes, Helene and Milton. First the massive Helene slammed into northern Florida with Category 4 winds, bringing record-breaking storm surge and an enormous amount of rainfall along the entire West Coast of the state. But that was just the beginning. States north of Florida also experienced Helene's brutal power. Communities all the way up to western North Carolina experienced some of the most severe impacts of this natural disaster. Many are still facing extreme hardship as colder weather is setting in.

Then, just days later, Milton zipped across the Gulf of Mexico to smash Florida again. With landfall just to the south, the Tampa Bay area was spared the worst of the storm surge, but hurricane force winds raged in already vulnerable communities, a series of deadly tornadoes tore through South Florida, and inland flooding affected areas far from the coast.

Not surprisingly, Masons, Shriners, and their families have been severely impacted. The Grand Masters of North Carolina, South Carolina and Florida have sought disaster assistance from the Masonic Service Association of North America* to provide urgently needed financial aid to many families who have lost their homes and possessions due to the forces of wind and water. I have personally spoken with all three of these Grand Masters and assured them of Shriners' strong desire to stand by them through this disastrous occurrence.

Shrine Masons are proud to have the opportunity to come to the relief of their brothers and families. Your immediate response to this need is vitally important to our brothers in those states and satisfies the high calling and obligation that each of us has to respond with fraternal charity. Your donations are being gratefully accepted by check or online.

Please take action right now to provide aid and comfort to our Brother Masons and their families who are relying on us. We can take the edge off of their pain. The word "fraternity" is defined by the action we take in this hour of need.





§325.11 Election Regulations

- (a) Electioneering. A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a resume consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.
- **Expenditures Prohibited.** The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.
- (c) Violation. For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.
- (d) Notice. At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.
